

## **CITY OF FERGUSON ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR SCATTERED SITE HOUSING PROJECT**

**The City of Ferguson is accepting applications from homeowners who wish to participate in a Scattered Site Housing Project funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and the HOME (Home Investment Partnership) Program. The project will include demolition and reconstruction of approximately 10-12 homes scattered throughout the City of Ferguson. Houses must need a minimum of \$25,000 in repairs. The maximum assistance amount is \$120,000. Low income elderly and disabled households will be targeted.**

**To be eligible, applicants must own and live in a single family home zoned for residential use located within the City of Ferguson for six months prior to applying. Owners of mobile homes are not eligible unless they own the lot and the mobile home. All property taxes and city utility bills must be paid in full and gross family income cannot exceed current limits. Anyone who has previously received CDBG or HOME funds to rehabilitate or rebuild their home is not eligible.**
