

PULASKI COUNTY ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR SCATTERED SITE HOUSING PROJECT

Pulaski County is accepting applications from homeowners who wish to participate in a Scattered Site Housing Project funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and the HOME (Home Investment Partnership) Program. The project will include demolition and reconstruction of approximately 10-12 homes scattered throughout the unincorporated areas of Pulaski County. Houses must need a minimum of \$25,000 in repairs. The maximum assistance amount is \$120,000. Low income elderly and disabled households will be targeted.

To be eligible, applicants must own and live in a single family home located in an unincorporated area of Pulaski County for six months prior to applying. Owners of mobile homes are not eligible unless they own the lot and the mobile home. All houses must either be connected to public water and sewer or have their water and sewer system approved by the health department. All property taxes and utility bills must be paid in full and gross family income cannot exceed current limits. Anyone who has previously received CDBG or HOME funds to rehabilitate or rebuild their home is not eligible.

Applications for this program are available at the Pulaski County Judge/Executive's Office, Pulaski County Courthouse, P.O. Box 712, Somerset, Kentucky 42502.
